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Introduction

The idea of using a synthetic representation for the description of venous therapeutic choices was proposed on February 2010 on Vasculab.

The version 5 release 1 was presented in the UIP Congress of Prague, 2011.

In analogy to CEAP or other Score Methods, the classification has a short name: W-HAT-MD, (the classification of Dr. WHAT) which takes its name from the sequence of items:

Letter Description

W Where H How

vessel

A Agent Trunk

-

MD Method Details

Composition rules

The V letter for Venous is a constant inserted to detail the venous system. Add a hyphen between W and H and another between T and MD. Add a comma, inside one letter in order to avoid ambiguity, when required. A comma separates items in the same description level. Add a "+" sign to link several interventions together Use parentheses and the order of symbols for combined features.

Discussion

Being the classification as_wide_as_we_can_require, the be upgraded with new symbols.

Undoubtedly there will be an initial difficulty in adopting these acronyms. So let us explain a practical issue.

Many people use a fixed technique. Generally, they choose a procedure maybe once and behave accordingly.

In a PC program you can set your ordinary default choices. These choices will be reported automatically, they will be not a problem for you, but will clearly set the difference with the treatments of others.

Example

Two phlebologists perform sclerotherapy with the same agent and the same volume, but have different adverse effects. This fact could be unexplainable, until you note the different length of their catheters, which means also a different dead space and so a different effective volume.

Using the electronically compiled WHAT-MD classification you specify this automatically and the difference between the two procedures becomes.
