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abtitle: Neurological pathology and possible correlations with intracranial venous disease

abstract: The study of the cerebral venous system has been substantially neglected for many years outside the neurological and neurosurgical specialistic evaluation of several diseases, as liquora hyper- and hypotension, transient global amnesia, primary exertional headache. The recent proposal of the impairment of the cerebrospinal venous hemodynamics in patients with neurological inflammatory diseases is discussed and it has been the subject of recent small studies and of a bigger one, in progress.

There are many indications in the dedicated literature about the methodology of neurological evaluation of the cerebral venous system, but the standardization of the examination protocol is seldom respected outside this field. these considerations make more difficult to compare the findings of some studies and requires to design further studies with a specific education of the participant sonologists.
